



THE 2010 OUR PLACES TELL STORIES CONFERENCE SCHOLARSHIP

The **Our Places Tell Stories Conference** has established a scholarship program to assist individuals from not-for-profit organizations, government agencies, tribes and educational institutions who are interested in attending the conference but unable to afford the cost of conference registration. Priority will be given to those applicants who volunteer for the conference, who are first time attendees, who work in the fields of environmental education and interpretation, or whose attendance would likely result in furthering environmental literacy in the state of Nevada.

Each 2010 OPTS Conference Scholarship will cover the cost of full conference registration, which includes all sessions (February 24-27, 2010), keynote speakers, and receptions. It will not cover travel, hotel accommodations, professional development credit, or other expenses. A limited number of scholarships are available. Organization/agency limits may apply.

Application Procedures: Complete and submit one application form for each individual for whom a scholarship is being requested. Applications will be accepted starting on November 15, 2009, and must be received no later than December 20, 2009. Please send applications to Allison Brody, OPTS Conference Chair.

Review Process: All scholarship applications will be reviewed by the OPTS Scholarship Committee. Scholarships will be awarded by January 4, 2010. All decisions are final.
